### EMPOWER THE 22%

More than one in five American adults has some college credits, but no degree. That's over 36 million people. Did they try college? Yes. Will they need college? Yes. By 2020, it is forecasted that 65% of jobs will require some college education—but only 39% of adults have a degree now.

Meanwhile, there are only 3 million high school graduates—and most colleges are competing for this small pool of students. Why are so many colleges and universities ignoring the 22%?

Invest in your future—and the future of our society—by becoming an adult-focused institution. Of course, supporting adult student success is a challenge, and it is difficult to decide what to do first. And that's where CAEL can help.

#### RETENTION

Adult students need different support services than recent high school graduates. Their priorities are different and the reasons they drop out are different. CAEL converts your services into adult-friendly drivers of retention.

#### RIGOR

You may already have administrators, advisors and faculty who are committed to serving adults. They may be eager to offer services such as Prior Learning Assessment to their students. However, how can you be sure this is done with the appropriate rigor and does not at all weaken the value of your degrees? #### ACHIEVEMENT

Adults enroll in college with great expectations, but too few reach their goal of a degree and secure employment. The proper support services, as well as programs that suit adults such as Prior Learning Assessment (PLA) and Competency Based Education (CBE), can make the difference. CAEL research shows adult students who did PLA were 2 ½ times more likely to graduate than those who did not. Other efforts, such as engaging with employers on curriculum design and aligning your advising with the labor market, can lead to career success long past graduation.

#### **DEVELOP EXPERTS** WHO LEAD

As you implement, at least one staff member must lead the way as the advocate for adult students. To be effective, these champions and changers need to expand their existing knowledge of PLA. We train them to turn ideas into actions and help them design processes that decode PLA in a way that garners school-wide support.



## IMPLEMENT CBE OR PLA INTERNALLY

You will need to develop deep expertise to set up your own PLA or CBE program. We can help decode and discover obstacles in your PLA policies, create a plan for training faculty and advisors, launch outreach and marketing campaigns and simplify process flows and pricing structures for PLA to encourage use by adult students.



#### **BUILD A POOL OF** CERTIFIED ASSESSORS

Portfolio assessment is the most flexible way to translate learning experiences into college credit. For this reason, it is also used in many CBE programs. We train faculty to understand the relationship between assessing learning and classroom assignments and discover ways to provide clear and supportive feedback to students.
